## Lecenté Create Builder Gel Application over Natural Nails

- 1. Remove any previous polish, enhancements or gel polish from the natural nails.
- 2. Perform **P.R.E.P** and a dry manicure.
- 3. Work a thin layer of Builder Gel into the nail. Apply onto 5 nails and cure on the Low Heat Mode/99 second button. Do not remove the tacky layer. Repeat on the other hand.
- 4. Working 1 nail at a time, **build and shape the gel** by placing a scoop of gel into the centre of zone 2. Using the very tip of the brush pull the product from the outer edges and pull out towards the cuticle (zone 3), free edge (zone 1), and sidewalls. Keep the bulk of the gel in the centre of the nail. Feather the gel to ensure correct shape before curing. Ensure there is a free margin in the cuticle area and any gel that comes into contact with the skin is removed before curing. Cure on Low Heat Mode/99 seconds button.
- 5. **Remove tacky surface** with IPA and **refine** with a 180 grit file.
- 6. Remove all traces of dust with a nail wipe and IPA.
- 7. **Apply a thin layer of Builder Gel** and cure. At this point, Create colour can be added or the nails can be finished with Create Top Coat according to our guidelines.
- 8. **Thoroughly cleanse the whole nail** with IPA and a wipe, paying particular attention to the sidewalls and the free edge.
